This first catalogue of Antiquariaat Digitalis appears on the occasion of the exhibition 'De wondere wereld van El Pintor' held in the Resistance Museum Amsterdam from June 3 until September 22. In that Museum, on June 26, author Linda Horn will present her biography of Galinka Ehrenfest (reference 1), who founded the collective El Pintor with her husband Jaap Kloots. A book highly recommended, though not translated in English yet. The same applies to the book by Saskia de Bodt and others, 'De Verbeelders Nederlandse boekillustratie in de twintigste eeuw', also highly recommended (reference 2).
